A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERINARY MEDICINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 471-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§471-2 License required. No person shall practice veterinary medicine, either gratuitously or for pay, or shall 4 offer to so practice, or shall announce or advertise, publicly 5 or privately, as prepared or qualified to so practice, or shall 6 append the letters "Dr." or affix any other letters to the 7 person's name with the intent thereby to imply that the person 8 is a practitioner of veterinary medicine, without having a valid 9 unrevoked license obtained from the board of veterinary 10 examiners; provided that nothing in this chapter prevents or 11 prohibits the following: 12 Any person from gratuitously treating animals in case 13 (1)14 of emergency; The owner of any animal or animals and the owner's 15 (2) full-time, regular employees from caring for and 16 treating any animals belonging to the owner; 17

1	(3)	Any student enrolled in any veterinary school or
2		college or any employee of a veterinarian from working
3		under the direct supervision of a veterinarian;
4	(4)	Any person from practicing veterinary medicine in the
5		employ of the United States government while engaged
6		in the performance of the person's official duties;
7	(5)	Any person licensed to practice veterinary medicine in
8		any state, or any certified scientist or professional
9		in animal care, from practicing in this State when in
10		actual consultation with or under the sponsorship of
11		veterinarians of this State; provided that the person
12		licensed from another state, or the certified
13		scientist or professional in animal care, shall not
14		open an office, or appoint a place to meet patients,
15		or receive calls within the limits of the State;
16	(6)	Any farmer from giving to another farmer the
17		assistance customarily given in the ordinary practice
18		of animal husbandry; [er]
19	(7)	Any applicant who meets the licensing requirements of
20		practicing veterinary medicine under a veterinarian by
21		permit; provided the applicant applies for and takes

1		the first examination scheduled by the board. A
2		permit shall not be renewed[→]; or
3	(8)	Any person who engages in cleaning dogs' teeth from
4		prescribing or selling antibiotics related to oral
5		health to the owner of a dog."
