A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003 established 1 the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii. Act 59 2 3 directed the department of land and natural resources to preserve the visual, cultural, and historical aspects of the 4 land, and to develop a comprehensive management plan for the 5 wilderness area. 6 The purpose of this Act is to extend the length of time 7 allowed to acquire the lands that are designated to become part 8 of the South Kona wilderness area on the island of Hawaii. 9 SECTION 2. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, is amended 10 by amending section 4 to read as follows: 11 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2003; 12 13 provided that: This Act shall be repealed on December 31, [2006,]14 (1)2007, if the exchange transactions to acquire the 15 16 lands described in section 6E-B are not consummated prior to December 31, [2006;] 2007; and 17

1	(2) In the event that this Act is repealed, any revisions
2	to land classifications that were made pursuant to
3	this Act shall revert to their original
4	classifications."
5	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
