A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE MEDIUM EDUCATION PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaiian 2 language medium education program was established to provide 3 students with a unique educational experience completely in the 4 Hawaiian language. However, additional funds are needed to 5 support enrolled students with the resources necessary to 6 fulfill program goals. 7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate necessary funds 8 to support the Hawaiian language medium education program. 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general **10** revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,300,000, or so 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to 12 carry out the purpose of this Act. 13 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the 14 department of education.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
