8		set by the department; [and]
9	(2)	Documentation that the person is the owner of the
10		vessel. [The documentation shall meet requirements
11		established by the department.]; and
12	(3)	In the case of vessels over forty feet in length or
13		weighing over two tons, documentation that the vessel
14		is covered under a marine insurance policy in an
15		amount sufficient for the recovery or disposal of the
16		vessel in the event it sinks or goes aground in near-
17		shore Hawaiian waters; provided that until January 31,
18		2012, this paragraph shall apply only to yessels
