A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 304-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: The board may charge resident and nonresident tuition 3 fees for regular courses of instruction at any University of 4 Hawaii campus, including any community college. 5 The board may also charge other fees for special programs 6 of instruction, as well as laboratory fees, course fees, fees 7 for student activities, and an information technology user fee. 8 The board may charge other fees for summer session or evening 9 courses, including differential fees for nonresident students. 10 11 The board may [waive]: Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the 12 (1)other fees for graduate teaching and research 13 14 assistants[. The board may enter]; (2) Enter into agreements with government and university 15 officials of any other state or foreign country to 16 provide for reciprocal waiver of the nonresident 17 tuition and fee differential[. The board may waive]; 18
