A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST ROSETTE STEEL HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the
- 2 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in
- 3 the public interest and for the public health, safety, and
- 4 general welfare.
- 5 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part III, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 6 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 7 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 8 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$15,000,000, in
- 9 one or more series, for the purpose of assisting Rosette Steel
- 10 Hawaii, a Hawaii corporation, for technology based manufacturing
- 11 of steel products for the construction industry to assist in the
- 12 development of affordable housing in Hawaii. The legislature
- 13 hereby finds and determines that the manufacture of steel
- 14 products constitutes a project as defined in part III, chapter
- 15 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the financing thereof is
- 16 assistance to a manufacturing enterprise.

    to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized in

    section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds authorized

    in this section, regardless of whether the outstanding special

    purpose revenue bonds or refunding special purpose revenue bonds

    have matured or are the subject of redemption or whether the

    refunding special purpose revenue bonds shall be bonds for the

    multi-project programs described in section 2. In making this

    determination, the department shall comply with federal law

    relating to the exemption from federal income taxation of the
    interest on bonds of the nature authorized by this section.

         SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
