A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "\$132D-3 Permissible uses of non-aerial common fireworks. 3 Non-aerial common fireworks may be set off, ignited, discharged, 4 or otherwise caused to explode within the State only: 5 6 From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New 7 Year's Day $[\div]$ and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on 8 Chinese New Year's Day [; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 9 p.m. on the Fourth of July]; or 10 (2)From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural 11 use is to occur at any time other than during the 12 13 periods prescribed in paragraph (1); 14 provided that the purchase of not more than 5,000 individual 15 non-aerial common fireworks commonly known as firecrackers shall be allowed under each permit." 16 SECTION 2. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 18 amended to read as follows:

1 "§132D-17 [Inconsistent county] County ordinances, rules. 2 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [no] a county [shall] may enact ordinances or adopt [any] rules regulating 3 4 fireworks (, except as required in this chapter,) that [is inconsistent with or are more restrictive than $[\tau]$ the 5 6 provisions of this chapter. [Any ordinances and rules regulating fireworks that were enacted or adopted by a county before March 7 8 31, 1995, except those provisions which are not inconsistent 9 with, or more restrictive than those of this chapter, are 10 declared void.]" SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
