## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"S237- Small business exemption for exported products.
5	(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, there shall be
6	exempted from the measure of the taxes imposed by this chapter
7	that portion of the gross proceeds derived by a small business
8	that is attributable to income received from the sale of
9	personal property or services sold in the State; provided that
10	at least ninety per cent of the total gross proceeds of the
11	small business is attributable to income received from the sale
12	of personal property and services exported out of the State.
13	(b) For the purposes of this section, the term "small
14	business" means a for-profit enterprise consisting of fewer tha
15	twenty-five full-time or part-time employees and receiving gros
16	income of not more than \$500,000 in any taxable year."
