MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PAY THE STATE'S SHARE OF EXPENSES IN A PARTNERSHIP WITH A PRIVATE OR NONSECTARIAN EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION TO START EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN COMMUNITIES IN NEED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 1
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$55,000,000, or so 2
- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for 3
- the department of education to pay the State's share of expenses 4
- in a partnership with a private organization that qualifies as a 5
- section 501(c)(3) organization under the Internal Revenue Code
- of 1986, as amended, or a nonsectarian organization, to start 7
- early childhood education programs (for children aged two to the 8
- third grade) in communities in need. 9
- SECTION 2. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the 10
- department of education for the purposes of this Act. 11
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006. 12
