A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MUFFLERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291-24 Motorcycles and mopeds, noisy mufflers; penalty. 4 Every motorcycle and moped moving under its own power on a 5 public highway shall at all times be equipped with a muffler in 6 constant operation to prevent any excessive or unusual noise and 7 no such muffler or exhaust system shall be equipped with a 8 cutout, bypass, or similar device. No person shall modify the exhaust system of a motorcycle or a moped in a manner which will 9 10 amplify or increase the noise emitted by the motor of such 11 motorcycle or moped above that emitted by the muffler originally 12 installed on the motorcycle or moped except a motorcycle or 13 moped that: 14 (1) Has three wheels; 15 (2) Is powered by an electric motor; 16 (3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and 17 Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system (4)

1 shall not be required to be equipped with a muffler. 2 As used in this section [-]: 3 "Muffler" means a device consisting of a series of chambers 4 or baffle plates, or other mechanical design, for the purpose of 5 receiving exhaust gas from the engine of the motorcycle or 6 moped, and being effective in reducing noise. 7 "Person" includes the owner of the moped as well as the individual or business that performed the modifications. 8 9 Whoever violates this section shall be fined [not more 10 than \$100] \$1,000." 11 SECTION 4.
