RELATING TO CONVEYANCE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "§247-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under 3 this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit 4 of the general fund of the State, to be used and expended for 5 the purposes for which the general fund was created and exists 6 by law; provided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year: 7 Ten per cent shall be paid into the land conservation (1)8 fund established pursuant to section 173A-5; 9 [Thirty] Sixty-five per cent shall be paid into the 10 (2) rental housing trust fund established by section 201G-11 432; and 12 Twenty-five per cent shall be paid into the natural (3) 13 area reserve fund established by section 195-9; 14 provided that the funds paid into the natural area 15 reserve fund shall be annually disbursed by the . . 16 department of land and natural resources in the 17 following priority: 18
