A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. With the severity of the current shortage in
- 2 social workers, the University of Hawaii school of social work
- 3 does not have the capacity to produce the number of social
- 4 workers needed to sustain the profession in this State. Unless
- 5 this problem is addressed, the State is moving towards de-
- 6 professionalizing social work positions, which puts service
- 7 recipients at risk.
- 8 A director of research will serve to develop a broad-based
- 9 research agenda for the school of social work. This person will
- 10 initiate research activities that will serve as the basis for
- 11 the development of effective programs in areas such as child
- 12 abuse and neglect, substance abuse including "ice",
- 13 homelessness, and elderly issues. Hawaii is lacking in
- 14 evidence-based treatment programs that support the promotion of
- 15 "best practices."
- 16 The funding for three additional faculty positions will
- 17 enable the University of Hawaii at Manoa school of social work

to offer a master of social work degree program that can be 1 accessed by residents of the State of Hawaii who would otherwise 2 be unable to pursue advanced degrees at the University of Hawaii 3 because of logistical and other related barriers. The proposed 4 distance education program will be extended initially to 5 residents of the neighbor islands utilizing a technology-based 6 format (i.e., a combination of two-way video and computer-based 7 technology) as the primary means for delivering course material 8 to students. The distance education program will increase the 9 total enrollment in the master of social work program by 10 approximately thirty-eight per cent annually. It has been 11 12 identified as a high priority program by the university administration because of pressing state workforce needs, 13 particularly on the neighbor islands, and the need to establish 14 better equity for neighbor island residents in relation to 15 access to higher education and professional training. Without 16 funding, the school will be unable to initiate the program. 17 An endowed scholarship will support social work students 18 who have great academic and professional potential and yet lack 19 the financial resources to pay for rising tuition costs at the 20 University of Hawaii. Many of our best candidates are from 21 modest economic backgrounds and first generation college 22
