BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 304-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 2 The board shall [adopt the necessary rules defining] 3 define residence for tuition purposes herein; provided that the 4 basic rule shall be that a student shall qualify for the 5 resident tuition fee only if the following criteria are met: 6 The adult student, or in the case of a minor student, 7 (1)the student's parents or guardians, has been a bona 8 fide resident of this State for at least twelve 9 consecutive months next preceding the student's first 10 day of officially scheduled instruction for any 11 semester or term in which the student is enrolling at 12 the particular college or campus; and 13 The adult or minor student has not been claimed as a 14 (2) dependent for tax purposes for at least twelve months 15 next preceding the student's first day of officially 16 scheduled instruction for any semester or term in 17 which the student is enrolling at the particular 18

2	guardians who are nonresidents of the State; provided
3	that this provision shall not apply in cases where the
