## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KUPUNA RECOGNITION DAY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§8- Kupuna Recognition Day. The fourth Saturday of
- 5 July shall be known and designated as Kupuna Recognition Day, in
- 6 recognition of the very significant role that kupuna play in
- 7 Hawaii's culture, history, and traditions. This day is not and
- 8 shall not be construed as a state holiday."
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
- 12 commemorate the establishment and observation of kupuna
- 13 recognition day.
- 14 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 15 department of accounting and general services for the purposes
- 16 of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
