- SECTION 2. Section 87A-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "[+] \$87A-19[+] Plans for part-time, temporary, and 3 seasonal or casual employees. (a) The board [may] shall offer 4 medical, hospital, or surgical benefits plans to part-time, 5 temporary, and seasonal or casual employees at [no] a shared 6 cost to the employers [-] in accordance with section 87A-32. The 7 board may [determine] exclude from eligibility [for] part-time, 8 temporary, and seasonal or casual employees who already possess 9 health insurance coverage through another employer or as a 10 retirement benefit by rules exempt from chapter 91 as provided 11 12 in section 87A-26. The board shall establish the medical, hospital, or 13 surgical benefits plan or plans, which shall be exempt from the 14 minimum group requirements of article 10A of chapter 431. The 15 medical, hospital, or surgical benefits plan or plans shall 16 provide, pay for, arrange for, or reimburse the cost of medical, 17 hospital, or surgical services, and may include prescribed 18 hospital in-patient and out-patient service and medical 19 20 benefits.
- 21 (c) The board [may] shall contract for the medical,
- 22 hospital, or surgical benefits plan or plans. Each part-time,

- 1 temporary, and seasonal or casual employee enrolled for medical,
- 2 hospital, or surgical benefits shall pay monthly contributions
- 3 directly to the board's designated carriers. The monthly
- 4 contributions may include the carrier's administrative costs."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
