A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that the
- 2 terms of a customer's health club contract with the seller of a
- 3 health club is honored by a purchaser of the health club.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 486N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 6 and to read as follows:
- 7 "S486N- Health club contracts upon sale of health club.
- 8 Upon the sale of a health club, the purchaser of the health club
- 9 shall assume all liabilities of the health club, including any
- 10 liability arising under a contract entered into by the seller of
- 11 the health club."
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
