## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KAANAPALI BEACH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is important to
- 2 keep Kaanapali Beach in Maui safe and free from disorderly
- 3 conduct. Police have responded to many calls regarding
- 4 assaults, fights, and other disorderly conduct as a result of
- 5 alcohol consumption after sunset at Kaanapali Beach.
- 6 The purpose of this section is to prohibit possession of an
- 7 open container, or consumption, of alcoholic beverages at
- 8 Kaanapali Beach after eight o'clock p.m.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "S281- Consuming or possessing intoxicating liquor at
- 13 Kaanapali Beach. (a) No person shall consume any intoxicating
- 14 liquor at Kaanapali Beach after eight o'clock p.m.
- 15 (b) No person shall possess, while at Kaanapali Beach
- 16 after eight o'clock p.m., any bottle, can, or other receptacle
- 17 containing any intoxicating liquor which has been opened, has a

- 1 seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially
- 2 removed.

- 3 (c) Any person violating this section shall be guilty of a
- 4 petty misdemeanor."
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun, before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
