## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY INCUBATOR.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The high technology development corporation (HTDC) provides assistance and resources to technology industry 2 entrepreneurs, start-up companies, employers, and job seekers in 3 Hawaii. Start-up companies have an opportunity to enroll in the 4 HTDC's Tech Center Program, and benefit from the facilities and 5 support services offered at several incubation centers located 6 statewide. Start-up companies may operate their businesses from 7 8 one of the incubation centers and share access to advanced connectivity, conference rooms, and office equipment. Companies 9 may also participate in workshops, seminars, networking 10 opportunities, and the Professional Service Providers Program. 11 12 The high technology development program wants to expand its 13 business and technology-based incubation services to foreign technology companies seeking to gain a presence in Hawaii by 14 15 first targeting existing technology companies in China, Japan, 16 Korea, and Singapore. During the summer of 2005, the agency entered into cooperative agreements with incubator programs in 17

- 1 Beijing and Shanghai to share resources and offices in China and
- 2 Hawaii. Hawaii is an attractive alternative to other technology
- 3 incubator programs on the mainland because of its closer
- 4 proximity to Asia and the State's culturally diverse population.
- 5 International expansion of the incubator program will create
- 6 more business and technology-based jobs, economic diversity, and
- 7 new external sources of tax revenues for the State.
- **8** The purpose of this Act is to provide the necessary
- 9 start-up funding to operate international business and
- 10 technology incubator programs and to enable state residents to
- 11 acquire the bilingual language skills, technology, and marketing
- 12 necessary to implement incubator programs in China, Japan, and
- 13 Hawaii.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 17 the high technology development corporation to establish an
- 18 international business and technology incubator in Hawaii.
- 19 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the

- 1 department of business economic, development, and tourism for
- 2 the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
