A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MILITARY AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Family members, friends, and co-workers in the
- 2 Hawaii national guard that were activated to federal active duty
- 3 and deployed to Iraq have been returning home and will be
- 4 demobilized just before April 2006. Plans are underway for a
- 5 welcome home celebration here on Oahu.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for a
- 7 grant to the United Service Organizations for welcome home
- 8 celebrations for members of the Hawaii national guard in the
- 9 counties of Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$35,000, or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, as a
- 13 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the
- 14 United Service Organizations to assist with their planned
- 15 welcome home celebrations for returning members of the Hawaii
- 16 national guard in the counties of Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai.
- 17 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
