A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEFINITION OF NEIGHBORHOOD ELECTRIC VEHICLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending the definition of "neighborhood electric vehicle" to read as follows: 3 ""Neighborhood electric vehicle" means a self-propelled 4 electrically powered motor vehicle to which all of the following 5 6 apply: 7 (1)The vehicle is emission free; (2) The vehicle is designed to carry four or fewer 9 persons; $\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ The vehicle is designed to be and is operated at 10 speeds of twenty-five miles per hour or less; 11 $[\frac{4}{1}]$ (3) The vehicle has $[\frac{1}{1}]$ four wheels in contact 12 with the ground; 13 [(5)] (4) The vehicle has [an unladen weight] a gross 14 vehicle weight rating of less than [one thousand eight 15 16 hundred] two thousand five hundred pounds; and 17 $\left[\frac{(6)}{(6)}\right]$ (5) The vehicle conforms to the minimum safety equipment requirements as adopted in the Federal Motor 18
