A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the statutes providing state and county immunity on certain public laws have 2 proven to be beneficial to the state and county governments as 3 well as the general public. The liability protections have 4 reduced the exposure of the state and county governments to 5 substantial damages and, as a result, allowed the state and 6 county governments to keep recreational areas with potentially 7 8 dangerous conditions open to the public. Furthermore, the warning signage required by the statutes has promoted public 9 safety by informing users of the recreational areas of 10 potentially dangerous conditions. 11 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the sunset dates of
