## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PART-TIME, TEMPORARY, AND SEASONAL OR CASUAL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 88F-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "S88F-2 State deferred compensation retirement plan for
- 4 state and county part-time, temporary, and seasonal or casual
- 5 employees. (a) The State may establish a deferred compensation
- $\mathbf{6}$  retirement plan in accordance with sections 457 and 3121 of the
- 7 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, for the benefit of
- 8 employees to defer a portion of their compensation to a future
- 9 period of time. Participation in the plan shall be [mandatory,
- 10 with] optional. If a part-time, temporary, and seasonal or
- 11 casual employee elects to participate in the deferred
- 12 compensation retirement plan, a mandatory payroll deduction by
- 13 the employee shall be made that is equal to seven and five-
- 14 tenths per cent of the employee's gross monthly wages, which
- 15 shall be contributed to the plan. A county may enter into a
- 16 formal agreement with the State to extend the State's plan and
