A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) In all cases where the registered owner of a motor
4	vehicle to which a notice of traffic infraction has been issued
5	fails to pay the total amount of fines, fees, surcharges, costs,
6	or monetary assessments that have been ordered, the court shall
7	cause an entry to be made in the motor vehicle's record so as to
8	prevent issuance or renewal of the motor vehicle's certificate
9	of registration and transfer of title to the motor vehicle until
10	the outstanding amount is paid or the notice of traffic
11	infraction is otherwise disposed of pursuant to this chapter [-]
12	provided that if the traffic infraction involves an unpaid
13	parking violation, this subsection shall not prevent the
14	issuance or renewal of the motor vehicle's certificate of
15	registration and transfer of title to the motor vehicle to
16	another person, in which case the clerk of the court shall issue
17	a clearance to effectuate the registration and transfer of
18	title; and provided further that in no event shall a clearance:



1	(1)	Absolve the registered owner of the motor vehicle at	
2		the time the parking violation was incurred from	
3		paying the fine;	
4	(2)	Prevent any subsequent issuance or renewal of the	
5		motor vehicle's certificate of registration and	
6		transfer of title to the motor vehicle; or	
7	(3)	Otherwise encumber the title of that motor vehicle."	
8	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall apply retroactively to vehicles	
9	that have	been prevented from being transferred prior to the	
10	effective	date of this Act by reason of section 291D-10(b),	
11	Hawaii Revised Statutes.		
12	SECT	ION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
13	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.	
14	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Parking Citations; Motor Vehicle Registration

Description:

Clarifies that unpaid parking fines and judgments do not prevent the transfer of a motor vehicle's registration and title by a registered owner of a motor vehicle who was previously issued a certificate of registration and certificate of ownership for the motor vehicle, despite the existence of unpaid judgments against the motor vehicle. Effective on approval with retroactive application to existing affected registrations prior to approval of this Act. (CD1)
