BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish an
- office of international affairs to coordinate and promote 2
- economic, social, cultural, and scientific relations with other 3
- countries. 4
- SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5
- amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 6
- and to read as follows: 7
- "§201- Office of international affairs; established. 8
- There is established an office of international affairs 9
- within the department of business, economic development, and 10
- tourism. The office shall be responsible for issues relating to 11
- promoting and strengthening relations with other countries and 12
- other duties as provided in this chapter. 13
- The office shall be headed by an executive director 14 (b)
- 15 who shall be appointed by the director of business, economic
- development, and tourism, without regard to chapter 76. The 16
- executive director may employ other personnel necessary to carry 17
- out the duties of the office under this section. 18
