## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR ATHLETIC HEALTH CARE TRAINERS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that additional athletic 1 health care trainers are necessary to provide quality care for 2
- student athletes. However, an increase in the number of teams 3
- and participants in multiple athletic venues has shifted the 4
- focus of care from implementing, conditioning, injury 5
- prevention, and rehabilitative programs to injury management. 6
- Additional qualified athletic health care trainers are necessary 7
- to adequately address this increased demand, and these positions 8
- should be made permanent and classified within the appropriate 9
- 10 collective bargaining unit.
- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to 11
- establish and fill 16.5 permanent FTE athletic health care 12
- trainer positions in the public schools that would be assigned, 13
- 14 and filled upon criteria established, by the department of
- 15 education.
- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so 17



- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 2 16.5 permanent FTE athletic health care trainer positions in
- 3 public schools.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
