A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Substitute teachers are a valuable resource to 2 any educational system and the department of education needs to encourage qualified people to serve as substitute teachers. 3 2004, the legislature realized that retired teachers bring a 4 5 wealth of knowledge and practical experience as substitute 6 teachers. Act 137, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, authorized an 7 8 exemption, for ten years, for retired teachers holding a teaching license from prerequisite course requirements necessary 9 10 for other substitute teachers. However, the legislature finds 11 that allowing such an exemption without any oversight may lead 12 to unintended negative consequences. The logical resolution to 13 this problem would be to allow the school's administrator to
