A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK ON THE NORTH SIDE OF WAIPAHU STREET, OAHU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that pedestrian safety is
- 2 important to the health and well being of the community. The
- 3 legislature further finds that the north side of Waipahu Street,
- 4 specifically from Waipahu Depot Road to Awamoi Street and from
- 5 Amokii Street to Waikele Road on Oahu, is heavily used by
- 6 children, adults, and motor vehicles. In this area, however, a
- 7 significant hazard exists for pedestrians, as either there is no
- 8 existing sidewalk or the sidewalks are in desperate need of
- 9 repair.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to ensure that this area is safe
- 11 for pedestrians.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$230,000, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, as a
- 15 grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu for expenditures
- 16 for the design and construction of a sidewalk on the north side

- 3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 4 city and county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
