A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an 2 amendment to article I of the Constitution of the State of 3 Hawaii to provide that the legislature may define what behavior constitutes a continuing course of conduct in sexual assault 4 5 crimes. 6 SECTION 2. Article I of the Constitution of the State of 7 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately 8 designated and to read as follows: 9 "SEXUAL ASSAULT CRIMES 10 The legislature may define what behavior constitutes a continuing course of conduct in sexual assault 11 crimes." 12 13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall 14 be as follows: 15 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended 16 to provide that the legislature may define what behavior
