BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 290, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "S290- Removal of parts from abandoned vehicle
- 5 prohibited. Except as authorized by law, no person shall
- 6 knowingly obtain, remove, or exert control over any part of an
- 7 abandoned vehicle, as defined in section 290-1, or a derelict
- 8 vehicle, as defined in section 290-8. Violation of this section
- 9 is a misdemeanor."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun, before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
