- 4 (1) A person is guilty of the offense of negligent homicide in
- 5 the first degree if that person causes the death of another
- 6 person by the operation of a vehicle in a negligent manner while
- 7 under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- **8** (2) Negligent homicide in the first degree is a class B
- 9 felony.
- 10 (3) In addition to any applicable fine as may be imposed
- 11 for a class B felony, and notwithstanding section 706-660, a
- 12 person convicted under this section shall be sentenced to an
- 13 indeterminate term of imprisonment of ten years, without
- 14 possibility of probation or suspension of sentence if, prior to
- 15 the date of the act for which the person is sentenced under this
- 16 section, the person has been previously convicted of any of the
- 17 following offenses:
- 18 (a) Negligent homicide in the first degree;
