(Act 118), was enacted, numerous trade associations have received group health

insurance. This affords the trade

affordable. The trade association in effect acts as a purchasing pool that can combine smaller businesses with larger businesses for possible premium savings or stability. Since Act 118 will sunset on December 31, 2006, it is necessary to delete the repeal

and make this provision permanent.
