A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR GENERAL ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005,
- 5 appropriated a certain designated sum to the department of human
- 6 services to provide funds for the general assistance program
- 7 under the benefit, employment, and support services division for
- 8 the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
- **9** June 30, 2006.
- 10 A critical funding emergency exists. Pursuant to section
- 11 346-53(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the general assistance
- 12 program is a block grant program. The maximum allowance a
- 13 general assistance recipient may receive is determined by
- 14 dividing the amount of the appropriation by the number of
- 15 general assistance recipients. The general assistance program
- 16 will expend all appropriated funds before the end of the current
- 17 fiscal year and the department will be unable to maintain the

- 1 benefit to approximately three thousand eight hundred fifty
- 2 disabled recipients. The current assistance grant for disabled
- 3 individuals is based on 62.5 per cent of the 1993 federal
- 4 poverty level. This amount is barely enough to cover living
- 5 expenses for individuals on a fixed income who have no other
- 6 viable means of support. Stopping the grant payment or reducing
- 7 the amount of the grant payment for these individuals poses a
- 8 real threat to these individuals' health and safety. To prevent
- 9 the reduction of general assistance payments in the fourth
- 10 quarter of fiscal year 2005-2006, additional funds are urgently
- 11 needed.
- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii, the sum of \$416,718, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2005-2006 to be used
- 15 for general assistance payments.
- 16 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 17 department of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
