## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELDERLY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a major deficiency

2 exists in the State's disaster planning and preparedness for

3 older individuals who lack family or service agency support.

4 The recent events of Hurricane Katrina and September 11th forced

5 our communities to recognize the extreme vulnerability of our

6 older populations.

7 A substantial portion of the older population in Hawaii are

8 socially or geographically isolated and not served by community

9 agencies. These people are particularly vulnerable in disaster

10 situations because they often require special transportation

11 services, have critical medical and pharmaceutical needs, and

12 have difficulty communicating due to cultural differences and

13 language barriers.

14 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation and

15 establish a community-based disaster planning and preparedness

16 pilot program for older individuals who lack family or service

17 agency support.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) There is created a pilot program to be
- 2 known as the disaster planning and preparedness pilot program
- 3 for older individuals. The department of health shall
- 4 administer the program through the executive office on aging.
- 5 The program shall target older individuals who lack family or
- 6 service agency support.
- 7 (b) For the purposes of subsection (a), the executive
- 8 office on aging shall establish an advisory group to identify
- 9 older individuals at-risk, methods of culturally sensitive
- 10 outreach and survival kits, procedures for training in emergency
- 11 and evacuation situations, and procedures for recruiting and
- 12 educating volunteers.
- 13 (c) The executive office on aging shall report to the
- 14 legislature twenty days prior to the legislative session about
- 15 the progress of the pilot program.
- 16 (d) This section shall be repealed on June 30, 2008.
- 17 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000, or so much
- 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 20 executive office on aging to establish a community-based
- 21 disaster planning and preparedness pilot program for older
- 22 individuals who lack family or service agency support.

- 1 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 2 department of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
