## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER LICENSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 302A-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1.
- amended to read as follows: 2
- "\$302A-802 Licensing standards; Hawaiian programs; 3
- The board shall establish licensing standards (a) 4 policies.
- that govern teacher licensing in Hawaii. Licensing standards 5
- established by the board shall be adopted as rules under chapter 6
- 91 unless otherwise specified in this subpart. 7
- In the development of its standards, the board shall 8 (b)
- consider the existing teacher applicant pool that is available 9
- 10 in the State and the level of the qualification of these
- applicants, as well as the nature and availability of existing 11
- preservice higher education teacher training programs. 12
- The board shall establish alternative licensing 13
- standards that focus on adequate post-secondary education, or 14
- professional experience, in the Hawaiian language. The board 15
- shall not make passing any national examination that tests 16
- knowledge of the Hawaiian language or Hawaiian culture related 17
- areas a condition of being licensed to teach in the medium of 18

the Hawaiian language, or licensed to teach in a Hawaiian 1 language immersion program, or licensed to teach Hawaiian 2 studies or other areas related to Hawaiian culture, or licensed 3 to teach in a Hawaiian-focused charter school, or licensed to 4 5 teach on the island of Niihau. For the purposes of this section, "Hawaiian-focused charter 6 school" means a school that uses instructional methods and 7 materials based on Hawaiian values, including the use of 8 Hawaiian culture-focused curriculum and pedagogy, and either 9 teaches classes exclusively in the Hawaiian language or offers 10 substantial Hawaiian language immersion programs and curricular 11 12 strands. The board shall adopt policies, exempt from 13 [<del>(c)</del>] (d) chapters 91 and 92, to initiate the following: 14 Develop a plan for licensing more individuals with (1)15 practical experience for teaching in 16 17 vocational/technical programs; Develop a plan to accept teachers from any state as 18 (2) long as they have completed state-approved teacher 19 education programs and pass relevant Hawaii teacher 20

examinations or their equivalent;

## Report Title:

Teacher Licensing; Hawaiian Language; Teacher Standards

## Description:

Requires the Hawaii teacher standards board to establish alternative licensing standards for teaching in the Hawaiian language. Prohibits the board from requiring a passing score on a national examination in Hawaiian language or culture as a condition of being licensed to teach in certain Hawaiian educational programs.
