## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S HAWAIIAN EDUCATION PROGRAM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need to
- 2 conduct a study of the effectiveness of the department of
- 3 education's Hawaiian education program.
- 4 The legislature finds that the Hawaiian education program
- 5 is a mandate of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, article
- 6 X, section 4, and is implemented in public elementary schools as
- 7 a Hawaiian studies and language program to assist students to
- 8 learn, understand, and appreciate Hawaiian language, culture,
- 9 and history. The program utilizes a kupuna (elder) component,
- 10 who is a community resource person with expertise in Hawaii's
- 11 cultural heritage. The kupuna assist classroom teachers in the
- 12 delivery of Hawaiian education program instruction. The
- 13 Hawaiian education program is a viable part of the perpetuation
- 14 of the native Hawaiian language and culture, and the board of
- 15 education's support for the program is an integral part of the
- 16 Hawaii content and performance standards.

1	The legislature further finds that many schools do not			
2	implement the Hawaiian education program in all grade levels,			
3	and the program curriculum is outdated and requires support and			
4	assistance by the department of education. A study would be			
5	helpful in assisting the department of education with the			
6	quality and consistency of delivery of the Hawaiian education			
7	program.			
8	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the			
9	legislative reference bureau to conduct a study of the			
10	department of education's Hawaiian education program to identify			
11	concerns and issues regarding the delivery and implementation of			
12	that program and submit a report of findings and recommendation			
13	to the legislature and governor before the convening of the			
14	regular session of 2007.			
15	SECTION 2. The legislative reference bureau shall conduct			
16	a study of the department of education's Hawaiian education			
17	program that shall include, but not be limited to, the following			
18	topics:			
19	(1) A review of pay scales for all kupuna associated with			
20	the Hawaiian studies and language program, with			
21	particular attention to pay equity across the program			
22	and from school to school;			

1	(2)	A review of the Hawaiian studies and language
2		program's support for professional development for
3		teachers in the programs:

- 4 (3) A review of the effectiveness of the program in

  5 complying with the mandate to promote the study of

  6 Hawaiian culture, history, and language, as provided

  7 in the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, article X,

  8 section 4; and
- 9 (4) A review of the program's development of curriculum

  10 and materials for use in the delivery of the program's

  11 educational goals.
- If the legislative reference bureau is unable to conduct
  the study by itself out of available resources, it may work with
  independent consultants and other entities as the legislative
  reference bureau deems appropriate.
- SECTION 3. The legislative reference bureau shall submit the study findings and recommendations, including any necessary proposed legislation, to the legislature and governor no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2007.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
