## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FUNDRAISERS AND FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Public perception that law making is influenced
- 2 by legislator's campaign fundraising should be eliminated.
- 3 During the legislative session, many individuals, businesses,
- 4 and groups see favorable action on bills from legislators. When
- 5 legislators solicit campaign donations from these stakeholders
- 6 while legislation is pending, the public has reason to mistrust
- 7 the law making process. As a result, the public becomes leery
- 8 that legislative votes are affected by fundraising activity.
- 9 Even with pure motive, public perception of the legislature is
- 10 lowered, along with public trust and confidence in elected
- 11 leaders.
- In the past, bills to prohibit legislative fundraisers
- 13 during legislative session have been introduced. For example,
- 14 in 2003, a bill to require public disclosure of fundraising
- 15 events while the legislature is in session passed the senate,
- 16 but failed in the house of representatives.
- 17 The legislature believes that holding fundraisers after the
- 18 legislative session has concluded will reduce public suspicion,

- 1 and result in increased public trust and confidence in our
- 2 elected leaders.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 11-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 5 "(c) No fundraiser or fundraising activity shall be held
- 6 during the regular legislative session; further, no fundraiser
- 7 or fundraising shall be held at any other time unless a notice
- 8 of intent to hold the function is filed by the person in charge
- 9 of the function with the commission prior to the date of the
- 10 function setting forth the name and address of the person in
- 11 charge, the price per person, the date, hour, and place of the
- 12 affair and the method thereof."
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
