## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AUTHORIZATION OF PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature believes that a terminally ill 2 patient's decision-making over the time and means of death is a 3 highly personal matter. A terminally ill patient's request for 4 the assistance of a physician to accelerate death ought to be 5 treated with dignity and respect. Therefore, the legislature 6 finds it appropriate, compassionate, and humane for the State to 7 authorize a physician to prescribe medication to empower a mentally competent and terminally ill adult patient, who has a 8 full understanding of the patient's options and consequences, to 9 10 exercise control over this intensely private decision. 11 purpose of this Act is to authorize physician-assisted suicide. 12 SECTION 2. Any other law to the contrary notwithstanding, 13 a terminally ill, competent adult suffering from an incurable 14 and irreversible disease that will produce death within six 15 months may obtain, upon written request, a prescription from a 16 licensed physician for medication of a self administered oral 17 `lethal dose.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
