A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE LIFEGUARD SERVICES AT THE MAKENA STATE PARK ON MAUI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Oneloa or "big" beach at the Makena state park
- 2 is known to be one of the best beaches in the State. The long
- 3 and wide sand beach, deep blue waters, and the vista of
- 4 Kahoolawe across the channel all attract thousands of visitors
- 5 daily. However, as beautiful as the beach and ocean can be, it
- 6 is also one of the more dangerous beaches in the State. A
- 7 number of lives have been lost there, and numerous unsuspecting
- 8 visitors have been injured in the surf.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 10 provision of lifeguard services at the Makena state park.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$427,682, or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 14 provision of lifeguard services at the Makena state park on
- 15 Maui.

- 1 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
- 2 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
- 3 this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
