A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 663-10.95, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Any waiver and release, waiver of liability, or
4	indemnity agreement in favor of an owner, lessor, lessee,
5	operator, or promoter of a motorsports facility, which releases
6	or waives any claim by a participant or anyone claiming on
7	behalf of the participant which is signed by the participant, or
8	in the case of a minor, the minor's representative, in any
9	motorsports or sports event involving motorsports in the State,
10	shall be valid and enforceable against any negligence claim for
11	personal injury of the participant or anyone claiming on behalf
12	of and for the participant against the motorsports facility, or
13	the owner, operator, or promoter of a motorsports facility. The
14	waiver and release shall be valid notwithstanding any claim that
15	the participant, or in the case of a minor, the minor's
16	representative, did not read, understand, or comprehend the
17	waiver and release, waiver of liability, or indemnity agreement
18	if the waiver or release is signed by both the participant, or

- 1 in the case of a minor, the minor's representative, and a
- 2 witness[; provided that a waiver and release, waiver of
- 3 liability, or indemnity agreement executed pursuant to this
- 4 section shall not be enforceable against the rights of any minor
- 5 or the minor's representative]."
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 8 begun, before its effective date.
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
