## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there has been a proliferation of flavored tobacco products marketed by cigarette manufacturers in recent years. Many of these products have
- 4 fruit, chocolate, honey, candy, mint, cocoa, or other flavors
- 5 that are particularly attractive to children. According to
- 6 public health experts, children are more likely to choose
- 7 flavored tobacco when they start smoking, in part, because the
- ${f 8}$  product names for flavored tobacco products are similar to
- 9 product names for candy, drinks, and other products marketed
- 10 directly to children.
- 11 The legislature further finds that the existence of these
- 12 products promotes the incidence of smoking among children. The
- 13 earlier an individual begins using tobacco products, the more
- 14 likely he or she will become addicted to and use them throughout
- 15 his or her lifetime. This presents a significant threat to
- 16 public health and increases health care costs.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to prevent children from smoking
- 2 by prohibiting the sale and distribution of flavored cigarette
- 3 products.
- 4 SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
- 5 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 "CHAPTER
- 8 FLAVORED CIGARETTE PRODUCTS
- 9 S -1 Definitions. As used in this part, unless the
- 10 context otherwise requires, the terms:
- 11 "Characterizing flavor" means any distinguishable taste or
- 12 distinctive natural or artificial taste, flavor, smell, or
- 13 aroma, other than tobacco or menthol, which emanates from or is
- 14 imparted by the cigarette, the cigarette's smoke, or any of the
- 15 cigarette's component parts at any time prior to or during
- 16 consumption.
- "Component parts" includes, but is not limited to, the
- 18 tobacco, filter, roll, paper, or any natural or artificial
- 19 substance or additive that is inserted or added to the tobacco,
- 20 filter, roll, or paper.
- "Constituent" means any essential part, component, or
- 22 element.

- 1 "Distribute," "distributes," or "distribution" means to
- 2 sell, ship, transfer, give, or deliver to another, or to leave,
- 3 barter, or exchange with another, or to offer or agree to do the
- 4 same.
- 5 "Entity" means one or more individuals, a company, a
- 6 corporation, a partnership, an association, or any other type of
- 7 legal entity.
- 8 "Sale" means every act of selling and includes any sale or
- 9 act of selling that originates from any order that is placed or
- 10 submitted by means of a telephonic or other method of voice
- 11 transmission, the mail, or any other delivery service, to the
- 12 Internet or other online service.
- 13 § -2 Prohibition. No entity shall sell, offer for sale,
- 14 or distribute in this State or to any person in this State any
- 15 cigarette or any component part thereof containing a natural or
- 16 artificial constituent or additive that causes the cigarette, to
- 17 have a characterizing flavor.
- 18 § -3 Remedies. The attorney general may institute a
- 19 civil action in the name of the State in the circuit court for
- 20 an injunction prohibiting a violation of this section. The
- 21 court, upon notice to the defendant in compliance with the
- 22 Hawaii rules of civil procedure, and upon proof that the

- 1 defendant has violated this section, may enjoin further sale or
- 2 distribution by the defendant. Each act of sale or distribution
- 3 in violation of this chapter shall be a separate violation and
- 4 one for which the State shall not be required to furnish a bond.
- 5 The court may impose a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed
- 6 \$5,000 for each violation. The attorney general may recover
- 7 costs and disbursements, including costs of investigation and
- 8 reasonable attorney fees. Nothing in this section precludes the
- 9 State or any other person from pursuing any other claims,
- 10 remedies, or actions available by law."
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun, before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on approval.
