# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is critical to
- 2 achieve universal health coverage for Hawaii's residents.
- 3 Hawaii's QUEST program goes a long way toward this goal.
- 4 However, the program cannot handle all eligible uninsured
- 5 adults, and a cap has been placed on participation in the QUEST
- 6 program, thus leaving out tens of thousands of eligible
- 7 uninsured adults.
- 8 The current cap prevents many adults, especially non-
- 9 pregnant women, who are income- and asset-eligible from
- 10 enrolling in the program. These excluded but eligible adults
- 11 are at high risk for not getting necessary primary and
- 12 preventive care, not getting necessary prescription drugs, and
- 13 are more likely to incur or generate unnecessary emergency room
- 14 costs because of their uninsured status. Uninsured adults are a
- 15 financial burden on hospitals, emergency rooms, community health
- 16 care centers, and others that provide uncompensated care.
- 17 The legislature further finds that almost fifty-four per
- 18 cent of the funds needed to cover all eligible adults under the



- 1 QUEST program can be matched by the federal government. In
- 2 addition, the cap limit has not been raised even though more
- 3 children are now eligible due to more liberal eligibility
- 4 requirements for children implemented in July 2000.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to expand enrollment in the
- 6 State's QUEST program by eliminating the enrollment cap.
- 7 SECTION 2. QUEST enrollment. The department of human
- 8 services shall not impose any cap on enrollment in the State's
- 9 QUEST program and shall enroll all otherwise eligible
- 10 individuals. The director of human services shall adopt rules
- 11 in accordance with chapter 91 to implement this section.
- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
- 15 expanding health care coverage by eliminating the cap on
- 16 enrollment in the State's QUEST program.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
