BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "\$134-11 Exemptions. (a) Sections 134-6 through 134-9,

4 except section 134-7(f), shall not apply:

- (1)To state and county law enforcement officers or a retired law enforcement officer; provided that such persons are not convicted of an offense involving abuse of a family [or] household member under section 709-906;
- 10 (2) To members of the armed forces of the State and of the United States and mail carriers while in the 11 12 performance of their respective duties if those duties 13 require them to be armed;
 - (3) To regularly enrolled members of any organization duly authorized to purchase or receive the weapons from the United States or from the State, provided the members are either at, or going to or from, their places of assembly or target practice;
