## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the business community, nonprofit organizations, and other entrepreneurs 2 require a functional, service-oriented agency that is readily accessible to provide business counseling, financial backing, 4 and general support to foster real community-based economic 5 development of the various products and services demonstrating 6 and embracing Hawaii's diversified economy. 7 The Hawaii community-based economic development technical
- 8 and financial assistance program of the department of business, 9 economic development, and tourism was established for this very 10 purpose. The legislature has authorized the Hawaii community-11 based economic development technical and financial assistance 12 13 program to provide needed financial assistance to communitybased entrepreneurs through low interest grants to qualifying 14 15 applicants.
- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 16 17 Hawaii community-based economic development technical and

18 financial assistance program.



- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 1
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much 2
- thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to 3
- provide grants under the Hawaii community-based economic 4
- development technical and financial assistance program. 5
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 6
- business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 7
- this Act. 8
