A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that the
- 2 issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in
- 3 the public interest and for the public health, safety, and
- 4 general welfare.
- 5 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 6 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 7 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 8 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, in one
- 9 or more series, for the purpose of assisting Kawaiahao school, a
- 10 Hawaii not-for-profit corporation, to finance the planning,
- 11 construction, and improvement of its educational facilities in
- 12 the State of Hawaii. The legislature hereby finds and
- 13 determines that construction and improvement of Kawaiahao school
- 14 facilities constitute a project as defined in part VIII, chapter
- 15 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the financing thereof is
- 16 assistance to not-for-profit private nonsectarian and sectarian
- 17 elementary schools, secondary schools, colleges, and
- 18 universities that serve the general public.



1 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the 2 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act 3 shall be issued pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii 4 Revised Statutes, relating to the power to issue special purpose 5 revenue bonds to assist not-for-profit private nonsectarian and sectarian elementary schools, secondary schools, colleges, and 6 7 universities serving the general public. SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is 8 9 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to June 30, 2011, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in 10 11 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be 12 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds 13 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the 14 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special 15 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of 16 17 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue 18 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in 19 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall 20 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature 21

authorized by this section.

1 SECTION 5. The special purpose revenue bonds issued under 2 this Act may be issued in one or more series for a single project, multiple projects, a single-project party, or multiple-3 project parties pursuant to the authority of this Act or the combined authority of this Act and any one or more other 5 6 separate acts of the legislature pursuant to part VIII, chapter 7 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the department may combine into a single issue of special purpose revenue bonds, in one or 8 9 more series, two or more proposed issues of special purpose 10 revenue bonds to be issued pursuant to part VIII, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, separately authorized, in the total 11 12 amount not to exceed the aggregate of the proposed separate issues of special purpose revenue bonds. 13 SECTION 6. The authorization to issue special purpose 14

revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2011.

SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
