BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately

4	"§342G-A Voluntary recycling programs; existing buildings.
5	(a) The department shall develop a voluntary onsite recycling
6	program for all buildings constructed before July 1, 2007.
7	Under the program, owners shall be encouraged to implement a
8	voluntary onsite recycling plan for all existing buildings. The
9	program shall provide for the:
10	(1) Separation of the recyclable materials from other
11	refuse;
12	(2) Collection by the State of the recyclable materials;
13	and
14	(3) Sale, recycling, or reuse of the recyclable materials.
15	(b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
16	91 to implement this section.
17	§342-B Recycling program special fund. (a) There is

1	fund. Al	1 moneys collected pursuant to section 342G-A shall be		
2	deposited	in the recycling program special fund. All interest

7	(1)	Reimburse building owners or operators for recycling
