BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	required to adhere to the county recycling plan, which may
9	require onsite recycling facilities. Specifically, the program
10	shall provide procedures for:
11	(1) The separation of the recyclable materials from other
12	refuse;
13	(2) The collection of the recyclable materials; and
14	(3) The sale, recycling, or reuse of the recyclable
15	<pre>materials.</pre>
16	(b) The mandatory onsite recycling plan shall not apply to
17	an exempted building. For the purposes of this section,
18	"exempted building" means:
