(a) When a governmental body contracts for services, a five per cent preference shall be given to [services 6 to be provided by nonprofit corporations or public agencies 7 8 operating qualified community rehabilitation programs in 9 conformance with criteria established by the department of labor 10 and industrial relations pursuant to chapter 91[+], or a responsive and responsible offeror that employs persons with 11 disabilities; provided that contracts awarded [under this 12 section] to nonprofit corporations or public agencies operating 13
