A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the elderly and
- 2 disabled individuals who are affected by the new medicare part D
- 3 drug benefit program provided by the federal Medicare
- 4 Modernization Act need assistance in defraying the cost of
- 5 medically necessary prescriptions. Act 209, Session Laws of
- 6 Hawaii 2005, established the state pharmacy assistance program.
- 7 This program was originally to be funded by negotiated rebates
- 8 from pharmaceutical companies. According to the department of
- 9 health, this rebate plan is not a viable option. Funding needs
- 10 to be appropriated from the general fund to the state pharmacy
- 11 assistance program a special fund, established in \$346-345.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 13 state pharmacy assistance program.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
- 17 be deposited into the state pharmacy assistance program special
- **18** fund.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
