A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC FINE SURCHARGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$291C-171 Disposition of fines and forfeitures[-];
- 4 surcharge; allocation to counties. (a) [All] Except as
- 5 provided in subsection (c), all fines and forfeitures collected
- 6 upon conviction or upon the forfeiture of bail of any person
- 7 charged with a violation of any section or provision of the
- 8 state traffic laws and all assessments collected relating to the
- 9 commission of traffic infractions shall be paid to the director
- 10 of finance of the State.
- 11 (b) In addition to any monetary assessment imposed for a
- 12 traffic infraction, the court may impose monetary penalties on
- 13 all outstanding traffic citations and judgments. The penalties
- 14 shall be established pursuant to rules approved by the supreme
- 15 court; provided that the amounts of the penalties shall be based
- 16 upon a graduated scale that increases in proportion to the
- 17 length of the delinquency. Any interest penalty imposed as
- 18 provided in this section may be waived by the court for good



- 1 cause. All penalties collected for such outstanding citations
- 2 and judgments shall be paid to the director of finance of the
- 3 State.
- 4 In addition to subsections (a) and (b), a traffic fine
- surcharge equal to ten per cent of the amount of the fine or 5
- assessment shall be added to each fine levied and forfeiture 6
- collected pursuant to subsection (a). The surcharge shall be 7
- 8 added to the amount of the fine or assessment and shall be paid
- 9 to the director of finance of the State, who shall deposit the
- 10 amount of the surcharge into the general fund of the county in
- 11 which the violation occurred."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 14
