- 3 "(d) The [appointing authority] director, as defined in
- 4 section 76-11, may [approve the appointment of] appoint or
- 5 delegate to the appointing authority the authority to appoint
- 6 persons without consideration of the requirements under
- 7 subsection (c) when services essential to the public interest
- 8 require highly specialized technical and scientific skills or
- 9 knowledge for critical-to-fill and labor shortage positions."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
